We are very pleased therefore that it has been agreed by those involved that the Mix Cafe (https://mersthammix.org.uk/) will resume provision of a hot meal at midday on Mondays, free of charge, to people who are unemployed, homeless, vulnerable, lonely or identified and referred by local support agencies. There will be a sign-up system in place. All Covid rules will be adhered to, which might mean delivery of meals in the short term. Eventually, it is hoped that volunteers can join the venture in its new form and resume the valuable personal touch that has been the essence of the Easter project for eight years. Sincere thanks to all who have volunteered, donated or supported the Easter Project.
