Twenty Second Sunday in Ordinary Time (year A) 30th August 2026

The Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill is back in the House of Commons and seeks to legalise assisted suicide. It will have its Second Reading and vote on Friday 11 Sep. The Church believes in the dignity and value of every human life. This Bill, if passed, could lead to vulnerable people feeling pressured to end their lives and risks putting many hospices and care homes in the position of no longer being able to operate.
