The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas) is on Tuesday (2nd Feb) this week, and brings another association with Christmas as, 40 days later, the parents of Jesus presented the new-born to the Lord at the Temple. Simeon, prompted by the Spirit, prays: At last, allpowerful Master, you give leave to your servant to go in peace, according to your promise. For my eyes have seen your salvation which you have prepared for all nations, the light to enlighten the gentiles and give glory to Israel, your people. It is a prayer of hope and trust and you might like to light a candle and say this prayer in your homes. It is a time, also, to take the Nativity crib down, or maybe (better) move it to somewhere less prominent but still visible in the home as a reminder that God is truly with us always, a message of hope and comfort particularly for our times.
