Book + Circle: Our next chosen book for our meeting at 8pm on **Thur 19th Oct** in St Joseph's Meeting Rm is "Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist. Unlocking the Secrets of the Last Supper" by Brant Pitre. All welcome.

Eucahristic Adoration: The first session of the Global Synod of the Church takes place in Rome 4th-29th October. This could be the most transformative event in the Catholic Church since the Second Vatican Council. Pope Francis reminds us that "without the spirit of prayer, there is no synodality". Please come to St Joseph's Church on **Sunday 1st October 3-4pm and/or on Wednesday 4th October 9-10am** to pray before the Lord.

Our Catholic faith – do you want to learn a little more about our Faith?
