Churches and lockdown easing Step 4

Following the Governments' announcement concerning Monday 19th July and step 4 of our Lockdown easing, late on Thursday evening we received updated guidance and recommendations from the Catholic Bishops of England and Wales on how to proceed in celebrating Mass and other Sacraments in the current climate of rising numbers of Covid infections (https://www.cbcew.org.uk/) Our Covid response team will be meeting during this week to consider the guidance carefully and to decide how the recommendations will be put into place in our three Churches for next weekend.

Baptism Preparation - we have about 40 families waiting to celebrate their child's baptism and there are still several restrictions in place but we can baptise now. If you would like to register interest please email the parish office.
