'Settled Status' for EU citizens. Our Diocese includes individuals and families from across the world. As a diocesan community we greatly value the presence, gifts and contributions of our brothers and sisters, who have come to live in the UK. A reminder to EU nationals, who have been resident since before December 31 2020, that the EU settlement scheme deadline is June 30 (this Wednesday). The UK Government requires that 'a timely application' is made to ensure people can continue to work, rent accommodation and access healthcare here. Individuals who hold permanent residence or a European Residence card as an EU national or a family member must also register for settled status (or to naturalise as British Citizens).
