Pope Leo XIV: The Diocese of Arundel & Brighton wel- Parish Sunday Lunch will be today Sunday 11th May, comes the election of Pope Leo XIV, the 267th Supreme from 12.30pm in the St Joseph's PNL centre. All are wel-Pontiff of the Universal Church. Responding to the news, Bishop Richard said: "We give thanks that under the guidance of the Holy Spirit the Cardinals have elected Pope Leo XIV. "Pope Leo brings to the office of the Holy Father considerable experience as a bishop and pastor including in Chulucanas, so closely associated with our diocese, together with his more recent service as Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops. His prayer for peace in his first words from the balcony at St Peter's will resonate with Catholics and all people of good will. With eyes fixed on the person of Jesus, our minds and hearts are opened to His call to us. I ask you to join with me in praying that those who are called to give their lives in service as priests, and those called to religious life, may be truly open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit.
