### Churches and Covid - Update

The Prime Minister has confirmed that England has moved away from 'Plan B'. Whilst caution is still expressed, many restrictions have been lifted as we try to move from 'pandemic' to 'endemic', both nationally and globally. Over the next few weeks we aim to introduce the changes which the Bishops conference has directed for us. These include a return to holy water at the entrance of our Churches, a reduced use of sanitization, and exchanging a sign of peace, though this does not have to be shaking of hands. Other measures now permitted such as the prayers of the faithful and the use of hymn books we have already re-introduced. Bishop Richard has issued some guidelines which he strongly urges us to continue:

- The wearing of face coverings for the protection of others and particularly during 'congregational singing'.
- A provision for social distancing for those who prefer this option.
- The use of sanitization on entry and exit from Church buildings.
- A good ventilation of the buildings
- Communion under one kind only

The Bishops of England and Wales have not restored 'The Sunday Obligation' but have issued a rich reflection on 'The Day of the Lord' which they urge everyone to reflect on. The full letter can be found on the Bishops website and attached to our parish website.

**Ash Wednesday, 2nd March, is the start of Lent.** It is one of two days in the year when the Church asks us to fast and not eat meat (the other is Good Friday). Masses with the distribution of Ashes will be celebrated at 10am at St Joseph's and 7.00pm at the Holy Family. If you have family or friends who are housebound blessed ash will be available to take home for them. Pope Francis said that his 'heart ached' in response to the situation in Ukraine, encouraging people across the world to observe Ash Wednesday, as a day of fasting and prayer for Ukraine.

**World Day of Prayer**, "I know the plans I have for you", prepared by the women of the UK, will be celebrated ecumenically at Merstham Baptist Church, Weldon Way on Friday 4th March at 11am & 7.30pm., and at Redhill Methodist Church at 10.30am. All are welcome.
